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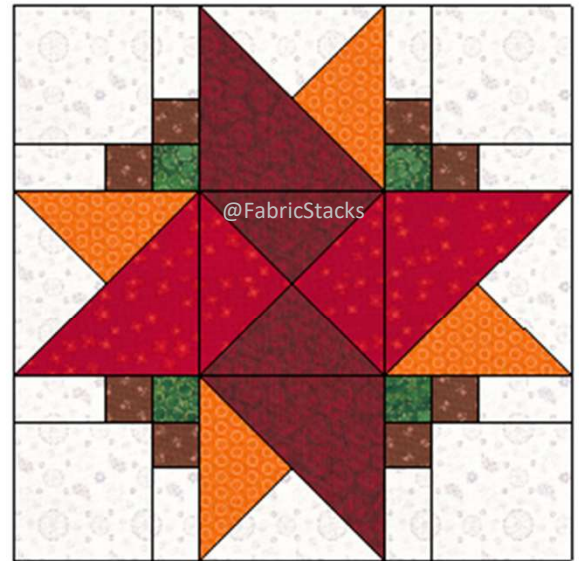
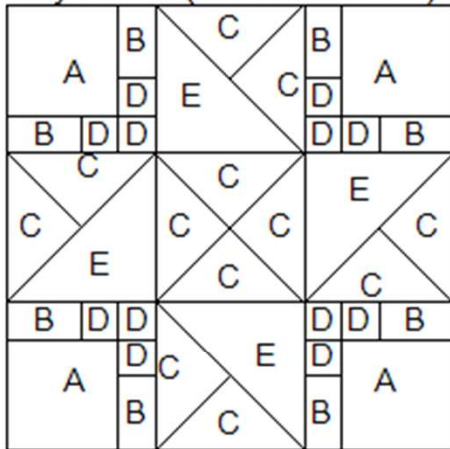
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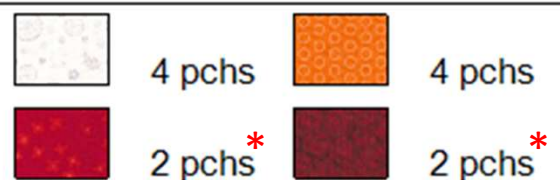
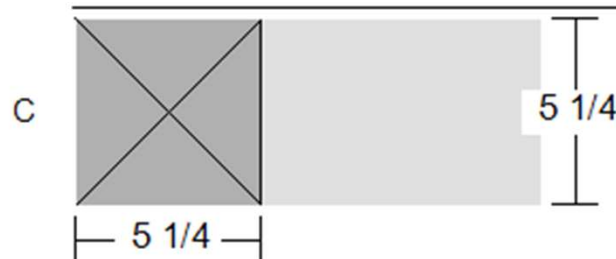
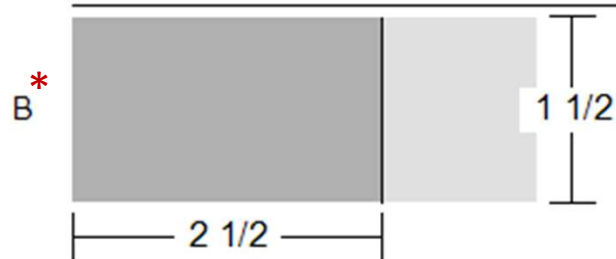
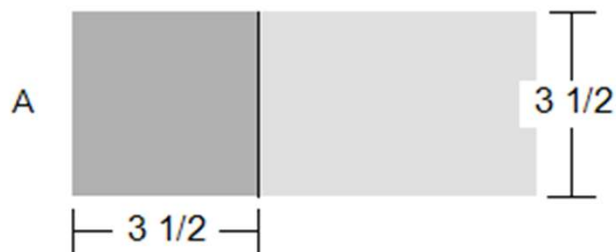


Ixora - FabricStack Free pattern (12" Finished)

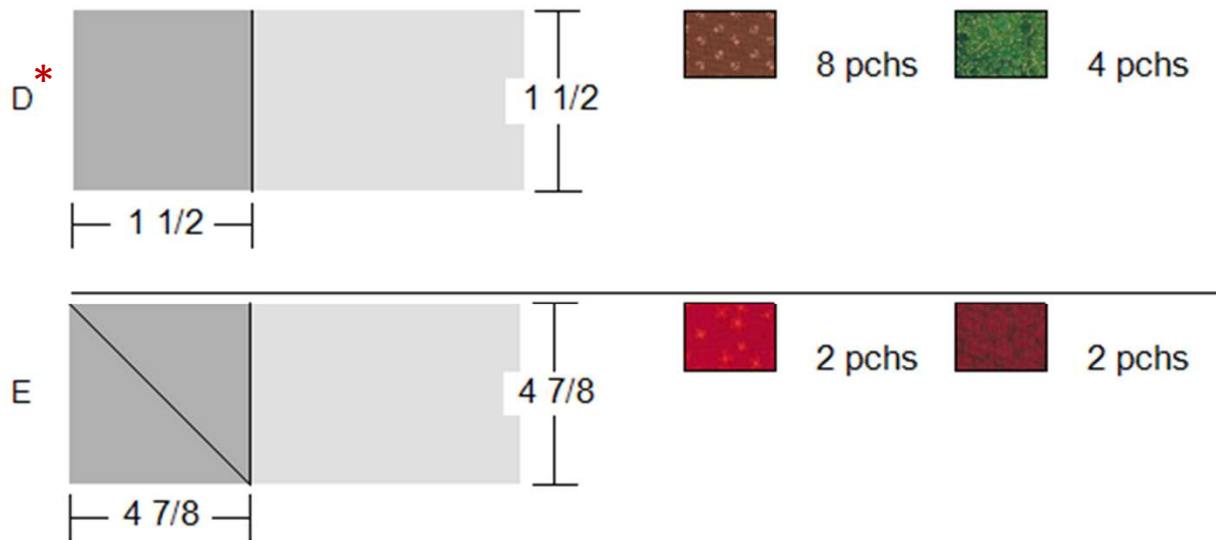
Key Block (1/5 actual size)

If you prefer to use the strip-set method, cut the following pieces:

- B  Cut 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip
- D  Cut 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip

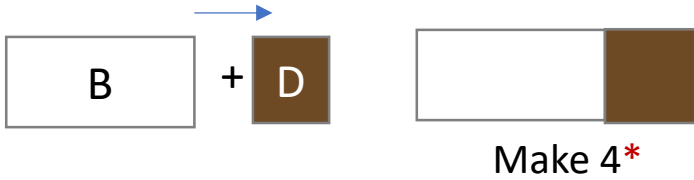
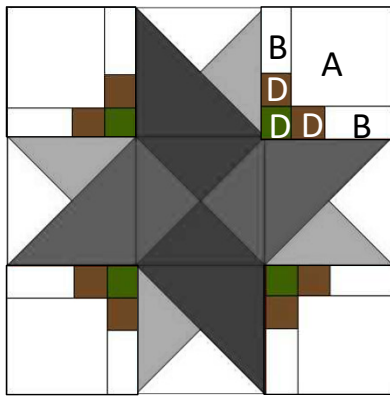
Seam Allowance = $\frac{1}{4}$ "

Pressing: Press after each seam to keep your pieces flat and crisp

Seam Directions =  If not indicated, press seams to either side.

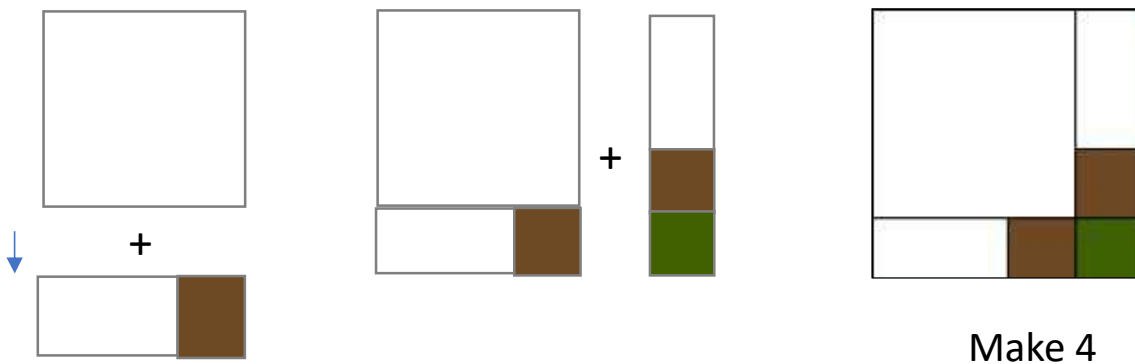
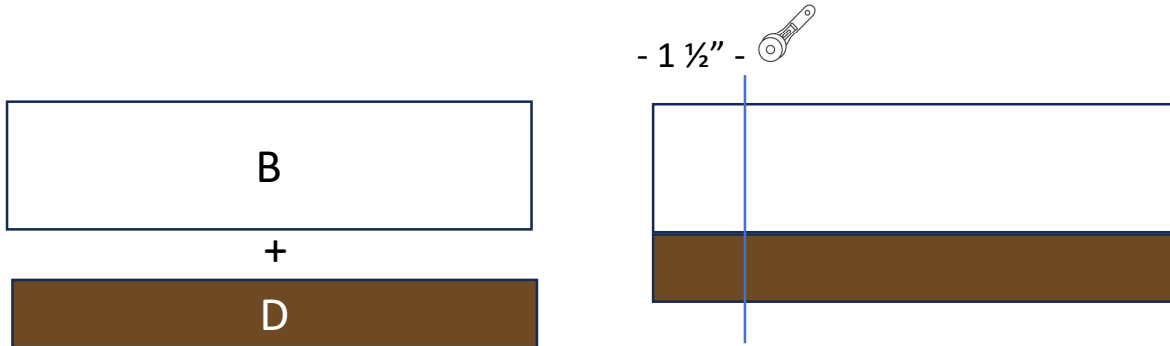

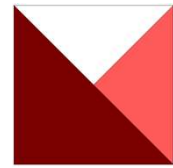
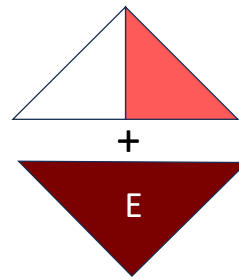
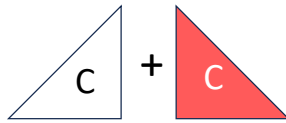
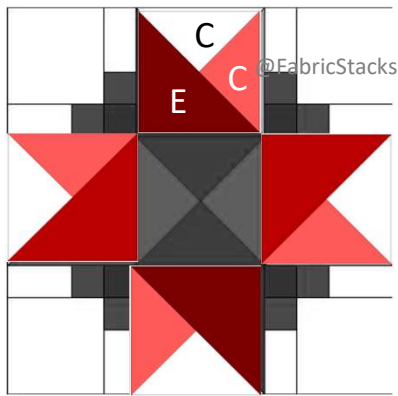
This block includes bias edges. I recommend spraying your fabric with starch and pressing it well before cutting for the best results.



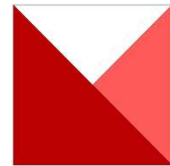
*OPTIONAL : Strip set method

Sew strips B and D together. Press the seam toward the D (1½")strip, then sub-cut into **eight 1½" segments**. Sew square D to **four** of the segments.

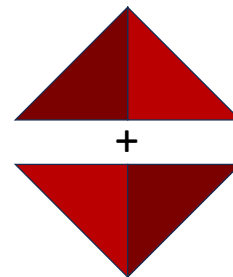
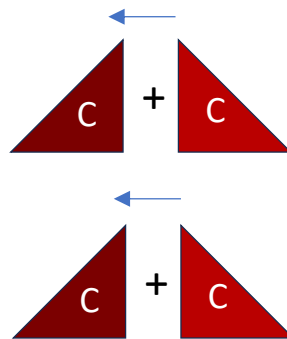
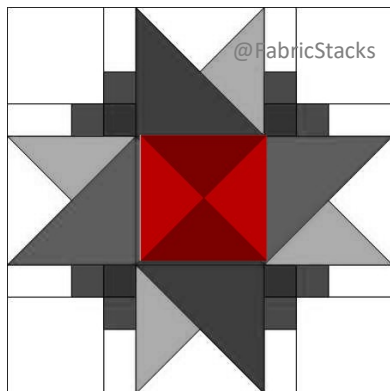

*OPTIONAL: Half-Square Triangle

Method

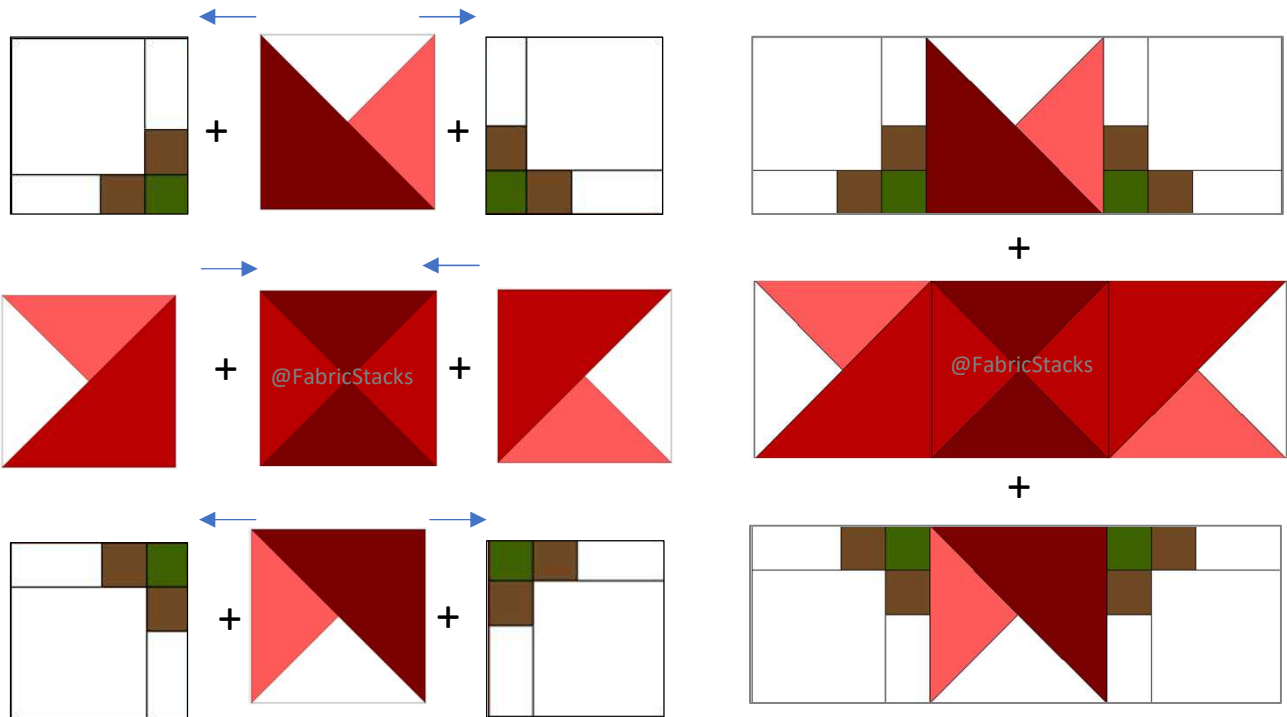
- Start with **two 5" squares**.
- Place 2 squares **right sides together**. Draw a diagonal line, sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on both sides, cut on the line, and press open.
- Place the 2 HSTs **right sides together**. Repeat the same process, then press and **trim to $4\frac{1}{2}$ "**. You'll have 2 Hourglass units.





Complete the block

- Follow the diagram.
- Sew 3 units together to make a row.
- Sew the 3 rows together to complete the block.

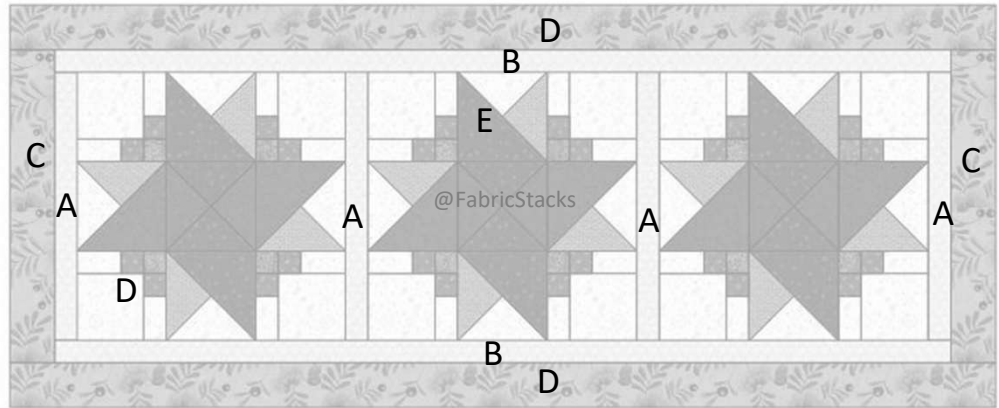

Cutting guide

A - Sashing (4) 12 ½" x 1 ½"

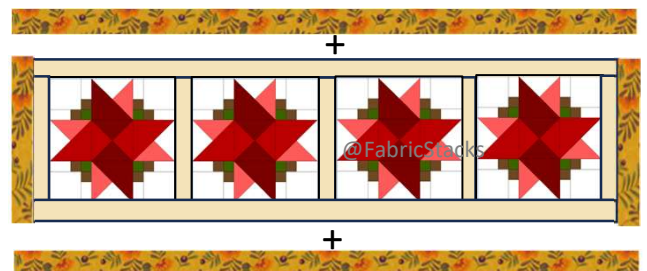
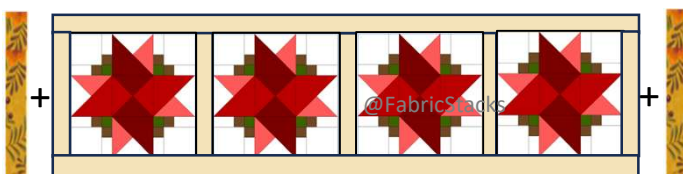
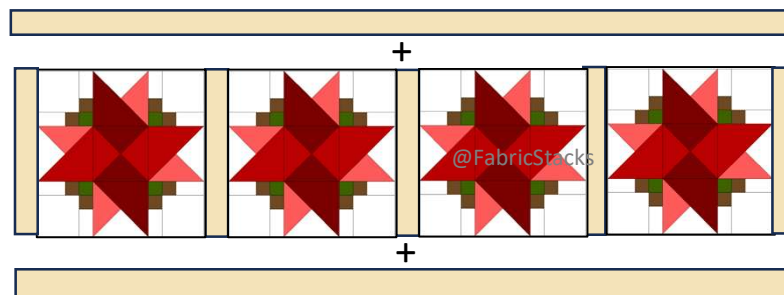
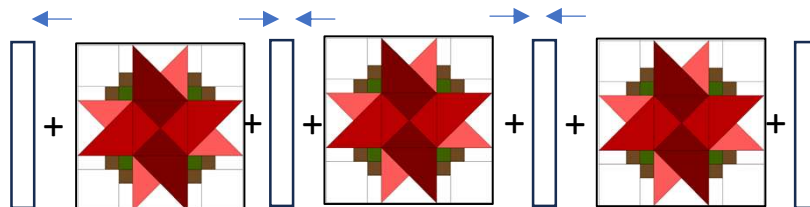
Inner border

B (2) 40 ½" x 1 ½"

Outer border

C (2) 14 ½" x 2 ½"

D (2) 44 ½" x 2 ½"





Complete the Table Runner

1. Make **3 blocks** following the block instructions.
2. Sew a **sashing strip (A)** between each block to create a vertical runner. Press the seams toward the sashing.
3. Add the **inner borders**:
 - Sew the **borders (B)** to the left and right sides. Press.
4. Add the **outer borders**:
 - Sew the **borders (C)** to the top and bottom. Press.
 - Sew the **borders (E)** to the left and right sides. Press.
5. Layer the quilt top with batting and backing, then baste using your preferred method.
6. Quilt as desired.
7. Trim away the excess batting and backing, then bind the edges to finish.

Finished table runner: approximately **18" × 44"**.
